Ken Burke, one of the non executive members of the nominating committee, presented the names of Jack Bright and Doug Cossar as new members of the club executive and called for any further nominations from the floor. Not receiving any additional names he asked for a show of hands in support of the two new

members and received majority support. Departing member Barry Clayton was recognized for his efforts by all members.

President Gwyer commented on the following in regards to our groups plans for 2018:

Continued development of our web site as a communication and motivational tool;

Active support and participation of the Dalewood marketing efforts to recruit new members;

Explore expansion of interclub matches;

A slide highlighting the relevant Dalewood 2018 membership dues was presented and it was agreed that a better venue for discussion of the numbers will be at future Dalewood Town Hall Meetings.
